KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION 2

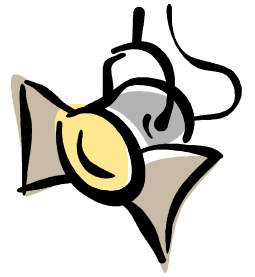
Thursday 6th November from 9.30 to 12.00 pm in the Kindergarten room for 123 Count with me and having fun in the playground.
