I look forward to hearing about the great sportsmanship and personal bests from our representatives on their return.

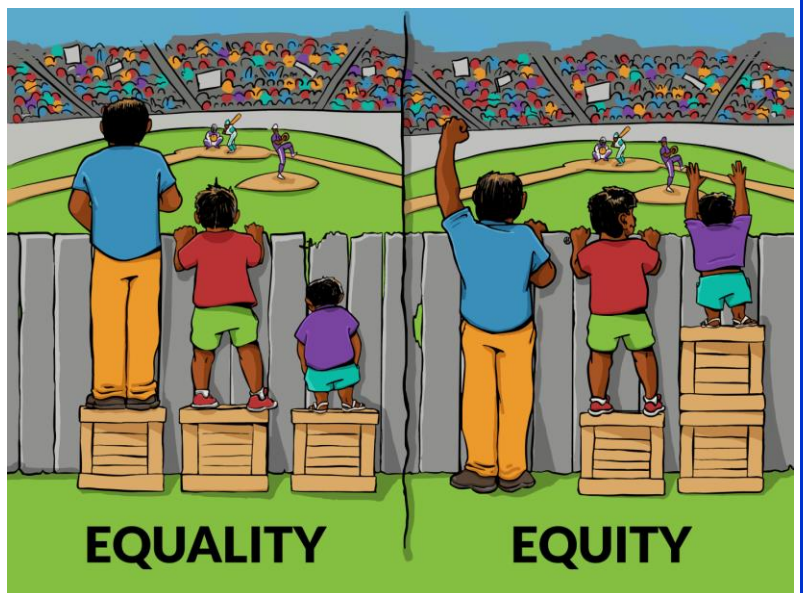
